- Interview opportunities with Maj. Gen. Bradley Becker, Army, JTF-NCR Commander; Brig. Gen. George Degnon, Air Force, JTF-NCR Deputy Commander; Command Sgt. Maj. Paul Biggs, Army, Command Sergeant Major; Mr. Mike Wagner, Lead Planner; and additional subject matter experts.
- A tour of the Caisson Stables housing the caissons and horses used in military ceremonies and other operational capabilities used during the Presidential Inauguration.
